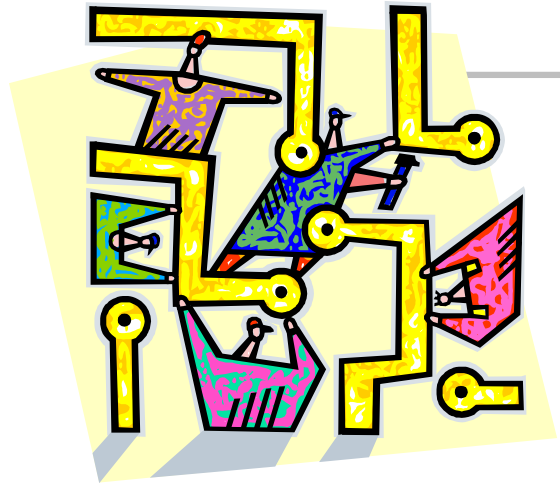


# AOD Priority Team

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Working within a general mission of providing support and guidance to those seeking to implement programs and policies designed to reduce and prevent problems associated with alcohol and other drug use by students of SDSU, the AOD Priority Team has set out accomplish three goals:

1. Assess and document the current activities, programs and policies designed to reduce and prevent problems associated with AOD abuse.
2. Develop a comprehensive strategy to provide a framework for future and current activity.
3. Support SDSU administration with information regarding activities relevant to SDSU's compliance with the Drug Free Schools Act.

Within each goal, the team accomplished a number of objectives, specifically:

### GOAL 1

1. Team members reported on ongoing activities within their respective domains.
2. Through discussions, opportunities to collaborate and reduce overlap began.

### GOAL 2

1. A draft comprehensive strategy was developed (see attached)
2. Through a process of matching current activities with the general structure of the comprehensive strategy it has become clearer where SDSU must focus additional energy. For instance, especially with the loss of Student-2-Student, there are no programs currently available capable of providing individually focused educational interventions to a large segment of the student body. Therefore, work is underway to develop such a program jointly between the Counseling and Psychological Services and the health promotion department of the Student Health Services.

### GOAL 3

1. A thorough review of the act was completed.
2. An assessment of the SDSU compliance with the act was completed.
3. Recommendations for improving compliance were drafted and sent to VP Kitchen (See attached).

### FUTURE DIRECTIONS

The next phase of the AOD Priority Team's activities will focus on the following:

1. Refinement of the comprehensive strategy.
2. Development of programs intended to implement the comprehensive strategy.
3. Creation of the Drug Free Schools Act report due October 1, 2002.
